

Student Sponsorship Policy



RATIONALE:

Ballarat High School students are periodically selected to represent Ballarat High School, Victoria or Australia at a national or international level.

School Council seeks to recognise and support such outstanding achievement.

AIMS:

To recognise and support outstanding achievements by students through means of School Council sponsorship.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- Students who are selected for national or international representation in any discipline (sport, arts, music, leadership etc) are ambassadors of our school and reflect positively on our reputation.
- School Council seeks to recognise and support these students in their endeavours.
- Parents of students who are selected to represent Ballarat High School at a national level or to represent Victoria or Australia may be offered a scholarship to assist with travel or accommodation expenses.
 - Students travelling interstate or internationally to represent Ballarat High School, Victoria or Australia may be offered a scholarship of \$200
 - Students travelling within Victoria to represent Ballarat High School at a national level, Victoria or Australia may be offered a scholarship of \$100
- Parents are required to write to School Council requesting student sponsorship.
- The financial assistance is not conditional upon performance, but it is expected that all students at any event will conduct themselves appropriately at all times.
- Sponsorship by School Council is subject to all family curriculum and service charges being paid up to date, prior to departure for the event.
- The school may allocate an appropriate staff member to attend the event with the student if it is appropriate to do so.
