

# **VCE** Requirements

## In Year 11 students must study:

- One English subject
- Five other subjects

## The five other subjects can include:

- Any Unit 1 & 2 subject
- A Unit 3 & 4 subject (Conditions Apply)
- A VET subject





# **VCE Requirements**

To be **eligible** for the VCE certificate students must complete:

- ✓ A minimum of 16 VCE units
- ✓ Three units of any English study this must include a unit 3 and 4 sequence.
- ✓ A minimum three additional unit 3 and 4 sequences

## What is the ATAR?

**Ballarat High School** 

'Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank' – a score that universities use to rank students prior to offering them a position in a university course

ATAR is calculated using Study Scores



Study Scores are given for each Unit 3 & 4 subject; they are calculated from SAC results and examination results

## **Year 11 Maths**

Units 1 & 2 Foundation Mathematics (Students can gain two VCE maths credits)

Units 1 & 2 General Mathematics (75%-80% of students in the state)

Units 1 & 2 Mathematical Methods (Strong maths students choose this)

Units 1 & 2 Specialist Mathematics (Elite maths students choose this)

Units 3 & 4 Further Mathematics, (if General is completed in Year 10)

## Aims of VCAL

- Provides students with an accredited pathway to work and further education
- Develop work related and industry specific skills
- Personal development







# Qualifications

- Students finishing VCAL in 2023 will receive a VCE (Vocational Specialisation) certificate
- They are recognised secondary certificates like VCE.



# **VCAL Entry Requirements**

**Places are limited** in VCAL due to a high demand so the following criteria will be considered, (first five points are essential):

- S in both English and Maths
- ☐ Medium to high effort in subjects, (report based)
- ☐ A written application and an interview
- Readiness for participation in the workplace
- Enrolled in a VET
- Strengths and interests
- Vocational goals
- Leadership capabilities

## **VET- Things to consider**

- Costs
- Some VET studies contribute to an ATAR score
- There is a lot of theory in VET course
- Structured Workplace Requirements must be met to receive the certificate
- VET has an attendance policy and students will be withdrawn if they have too many absences



# Things to consider continued

- All students undertaking VET must obtain a Unique Student Identifier <a href="https://www.usi.gov.au/your-usi/create-usi">https://www.usi.gov.au/your-usi/create-usi</a>
- An expression of interest form must be submitted at course confirmation interviews located on course counselling website.
- Most VET courses run through the Highland LLEN cluster will require an orientation/interview as well as a Language, Literacy and Numeracy Test.
- Some courses have classes in the school holidays



## **MANAGED INDIVIDUAL PATHWAYS**

- Assist student transition to university, TAFE, other training or employment options
- Provide individual course counselling & pathways planning from years 9-12
- Coordinate work experience programs
- Support school based apprenticeship/traineeships



## **School Based Apprenticeships**

"Earn and Learn"

### **Students:**

- Can only combine an SBA with VCAL (not VCE)
- Attend 1 day each week on the job (paid)



- Attend 1 day each week for theory the timing will depend on the provider.
- o 3 days at school (adjusted timetable)



## **Benefits of a School Based Apprenticeship**

- Connections for future employment
- Get paid while you are studying
- Gain a certificate qualification in your trade/occupational area
- Credit for theory work already completed





## Sourcing an SBA

- Find an employer first often through family networks and connections
- Organise work experience to try different occupations
- Some providers offer class based models for Educational Support, Early Childhood and Allied Health

**Tick It English** 

- Students cannot choose a Unit 3/4 subject in 2022 if the Unit 1/2 was not completed in 2021
- English is compulsory
- Students' current maths teacher will recommend which maths they should continue with. Please listen to their expert advice.
- If you choose VCAL you must be enrolled in VET.
